

This slowed things down quite a bit and those of us who were there early were required to stand in line for about a half hour. Others, who had arrived even earlier stood in line for nearly an hour.

I was relieved and voted as quickly as I could. Then I got out of there hoping to do my part both in voting and in facilitating a timely process. The polls are busy, and it appears that in this polling location that many more voters than normal are getting out to vote today. One can only hope that the outcome of the vote will be such that God is honored, and our nation can move once more towards healing and greater integrity.

I say that because as I look at behavioral trends in our society, I do not see a culture that is moving towards loving God and loving our neighbor with a love that seeks the highest good of the other. I see a society that in many ways is broken and dysfunctional, and for the most part turns a blind eye to those in desperate need.

I see a society that is largely consumed with the preoccupation of consuming 3 large meals each day and then wondering why we are tormented with countless health issues. I see a society so controlled by greed that as a nation we are guilty of not only abandoning children through irresponsibility but murdering and abusing them through the profession of medicine by offering abortion to expectant mothers, and gender transition surgeries to young children. Life is God given; God's fingerprint of glory is upon each one of his creatures as well as the creation from the earth to the heavens!

My mind goes to the words of the prophet Ezekiel who was used of God to explain why Sodom and Gomorrah really came under God's judgment and wrath. Ezekiel declares in chapter 16:49: "Behold, this was the guilt of your sister Sodom: she and her daughters had pride, surfeit of food, and prosperous ease, but did not aid the poor and needy."

I am also aware and rejoice that God guides the hearts of humankind as stated in Proverbs 21:1 "The king's heart is in the hand of the LORD, like the rivers of water; He turns it wherever He wishes." As a pastor, I've urged you to pray leading up to this election. And I continue to urge you to continue to pray today, that God would direct us as well as those who are elected to repent and turn to him and allow God to continue to lead us in the way that brings Him much glory and shows love and compassion to our fellowman. 





WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY


