

RON'S REFLECTIONS

How do you approach a new year? As I look forward to 2025, I am reminded of the words of the Apostle Paul as he wrote to the church in Philippi. He declared: "Brothers, I do not consider that I have made it my own. But one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus. Let those of us who are mature think this way, and if in anything you think otherwise, God will reveal that also to you. Only let us hold true to what we have attained." Philippians 3:13-16.

How could Paul, who had faced all kinds of trials and hardship, make such a declaration you may ask? Paul could say these things because he had discovered in his own words, "the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus as my Lord." Philippians 3:8 Knowing Jesus personally makes all the difference! Do you know him?

This morning, I had a conversation with a dear brother in Christ who is 35 years my senior. He asked me the question, "is believing in God the same or different than believing in Jesus?" As I took a minute to consider his question, the Holy Spirit brought the familiar words of John 3:16 to my mind. "For God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish but have everlasting life!"

Is there a difference in believing that there is a God and in believing and receiving Jesus Christ as Lord (boss or king of your life) as Paul did? Absolutely! The apostle James says that "even the demons believe and tremble!" James 2:19b. However, they have chosen to follow one who decided not to humble himself but instead strove to be equal with God. Isaiah 14:12-15 Jesus came from God, laying aside the glory he shared with Him to show us the Father and to bring us to Him. Philippians 2:1-9.

So, as you and I face this new year that God through his daily grace and mercy has given us to experience, let's make the decision to daily press in and take hold of Jesus! He came to bring us to the Father! 2 Corinthians 5:18 The worth of knowing Jesus is truly infinite and eternal in worth!

Whatever you are facing today, do not face it alone, bring it to Jesus. Cry out to him from your heart, lay your requests and partitions before God and Jesus will join you in interceding to the Father for you! Get to know the will of the Father and his promises by purposing to read and study his word daily. Take it one step further and reorder your schedule to join in with others of us at Cornerstone who are seeking the heart of God through the Savior of the world Jesus Christ who is one with God the Father in purpose and power. 2 Peter 1:1-3.

Finally, I invite you to join me as we step into 2025. Let's press into Jesus together! Let's get to know him better together! Let's pray for each other together! Let's reach out to our loved ones with the good news of Jesus together. He is our high calling; Jesus holds the words of eternal life! Forgetting what is behind let's press on towards maturity to take hold of what Christ Jesus took hold for us!






