Ron's Reflections

I need reminders, do you? In our daily lives many of us keep track through; our phone schedules, or "post it notes", or scribble dates, times and doctor appointments on kitchen calendars and even ask those close to us to remind us or help us remember those important events like birthdays, anniversaries, doctor appointments and currently graduation parties! How are you doing, have you forgotten something important recently?

Spiritually, I need reminders as well. Last week in preparation for Sunday I got to spend a lot of time studying and meditating in Acts 21:17-26. It was great food for my soul and gave me numerous spiritual reminders that I needed to hear and even jot down a few reminders. It seems that I was forgetting some of these very important truths and needed this spiritual jog or nudge to the memory bank of my heart.

The Apostle Paul is certainly one of my heroes and one of the things that Luke recounted with clarity in this passage was that when Paul returned to Jerusalem and gave an account of his ministry to the Jerusalem church leaders he did well in keeping the main thing front and center. What did he do you may ask? Here are some of the things I find noteworthy...

As Paul shared about his ministry in Ephesus and the many other places that he had been, he gave great detail of all the incredible events and breakthroughs, but with the focus on what God had done not on what he had done. I think this is a great reminder to me that it is not about what I do or think I've accomplished. God is the power, the life giver and the One through whom everything is accomplished. God deserves all glory, all the time, every time.

Also in this passage, I see that Paul is under great pressure! So, I found it helpful to step back and just take a look at how Paul exhibited great meekness, a fruit of the Spirit evidenced in his attitude and actions, even though he had been warned by the Spirit that great hardship faced him as he came to Jerusalem. Paul has much to teach me here. I can get uptight, anxious and angry when I forget that my life is now hidden in Christ and that there is nothing that can separate me or any Christ follower from the love of God which is found in Christ Jesus our Lord! Romans 8:33-39.

Another thing that I see powerfully in this passage is; Paul was winsome to win some! He mentions this later in a letter to the Church in Corinth, 1 Cor. 9:20-22. In spite of the tremendous pressure on him, hatred towards him and threats on his life, Paul stayed true to his calling and focus and that was to win as many as possible, both Jews and Gentiles, to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ. I need to stay focused on what God has called me to do. How about you?

Finally, Paul kept his word to the leaders of the Jerusalem Church and followed through with his commitment to them and in honoring them even though their plan for a peaceful resolution backfired and Paul ultimately found himself in trouble with those who hated him and were out to kill him. Paul offered no retaliation towards them, no harsh or accusatory verbal attacks on his brothers. Reminder: Love God, love your Church and love your neighbors and your enemies! Jesus did. Paul did. Let's give it a try too!

These are great reminders for me, I hope they've blessed and challenged you too! Love ya! Pastor Ron


