Nearly everyone loves a kiss! What?! Yes, I just said it! I know I do! Especially when it is a spontaneous one from the sweetest woman ever, my wife of 41 years! Now that I have your attention and you are either grossed out or wanting to know more... Well, I'll tell you some more! KISS is also an acrostic for Keep. It. Simple. Stupid. Now I know you are really wondering what I'm up to today!

Here are the simple facts. This past Sunday Dan Kamwesa, executive director of the Vincent house, brought an incredible message to the congregation at Cornerstone by keeping it simple. He took us to the scripture. Yes, just one verse to get our attention! The verse he took us to was Mark 1:15. Here Jesus made this famous statement; "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel."

When Jesus came, he fulfilled all that was written about his coming in the Old Testament. Jesus came just at the right time. Jesus came to announce and usher in the Kingdom of God. The same God who created the world, the same God to whom Jesus taught his disciples to pray "Our Father who art in Heaven, hallowed be thy name, thy Kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in Heaven."

Jesus who is the Savior, the Messiah, the substitute who took our place on the cross for our sin, Jesus. So what Jesus was saying was: Now is the time to change your mind and direction, trust and follow me because I am your one and only Savior! There you have it. Nice and Simple. Just like that sweet Kiss! This my friend is the "KISS" of life! Keep it simple by repenting today, turning from sin, believing in Jesus the author of our faith and Savior of our souls!

Now, go and share this too good to be true "gospel" with your family, friends and neighbors! It is too good and too simple to keep to yourselves! Love ya!
