

RON'S REFLECTIONS

As I have followed the recent devastation caused by hurricane Helene in the mountains of western North Carolina and the surrounding regions, I have experienced a multitude of emotions. It is truly unsettling to imagine the terror and total hopelessness the residents of these mountains must have felt as they looked out their doors and windows at the rising waters, the ripping monstrous mudslides, and the plight of their families and neighbors themselves being swept away by the fury of this storm.

The aftermath, the sight day after day of the twisted rubble of the remains of houses, trees, cars and all that one has ever owned would only add to the sense of loss and hopelessness. The question of what to do, how to move forward, where to begin, after such tremendous loss, even observing from a distance has often during the last month given me a sense of feeling overwhelmed.

This morning, I was listening to a survivor of this disaster share how upon looking at the aftermath and the immensity of the task of beginning to rebuild, he resolved to just begin by taking one very small step, and then another. Just one small step towards resolving an impossible situation begins the process of rebuilding.

Now 30 days later, while it seems that our national leadership has forgotten the plight of those who have lost everything including family members and are preoccupied with the presidential race to the White house, thousands of people have responded with compassion. They have dropped everything to come in and lend hearts and hands and generously give millions of dollars to rescue, bring relief, help in recovery and to begin the clean out and rebuilding process. Everyday there are more and more stories being shared of incredible, miraculous provision and break throughs in this monstrous effort to recover, rebuild and start over again. The work is far from over. It will require many months and many volunteers and much more generosity. There will be many opportunities in the coming months to lend a helping hand.

This past weekend we also had the opportunity to come together to receive donations of winter clothing, pampers for babies, portable heaters and cook stoves and food that will join other much needed items that will be sent down to the affected region next week. Once more my heart was filled with emotion as I witnessed the generosity of my brothers and sisters and friends from Cornerstone. Thank you for your compassion for others!

It has also led me to reflect on this quote: "All of our difficulties are not solved the moment we are converted to Christ, but conversion does mean that we can approach our problem with a new attitude and in new strength." You may feel like your life is a disaster. And it may well be. You may feel that what you are facing is too overwhelming to ever recover. Today, I want to encourage you to begin by taking one small step. Take that one small step towards Jesus. He will give you the strength and the attitude to persevere. Jesus can rescue and restore you. He can give you a hope and a future. Come, we are waiting for you at Cornerstone. Let's take that step together. Love ya!




Jason & Chelsea Breda's


MEN'S BIBLE STUDY
